
Berthing Facilities

BSE Cairns Slipways provides 360 metres of wharf space with alongside maximum depths of 5 metres at zero tide.

Bunkering

Fuel companies can access vessels at our wharves for re-fuelling 24 hours a day using mobile tankers.

Communications

Landlines are available for ship's communications.

Mobile Cranes

6 and 20 ton mobile cranes and 30, 50 and 70 ton non-mobile cranes are available to unload and load tenders, ship's gear and equipment for storage.

Fendering

Most of the wharves have timber fendering, however it is advisable for Ship's to use their own portable fendering system during berthing.

Freshwater

Freshwater supply fed through 1" and 3" pipelines and suitable for human consumption.

Layout and access

360 metres of wharf space available for fit-out work including a floating wharf incorporating access ramps to facilitate deliveries, cranes and providing access to vessels.

Pontoons

A large scaffolding pontoon is available for hire, as well as three smaller pontoons for in water work.

Ship's Waste Removal

Removal of waste oil and waste bilge water, as well as ship's general waste can be arranged during berthing periods.

Waste bins / Skips

Waste bins / skips can be located around the site; food scraps are to be disposed off in-the appropriate marked bins.

Shore Power

Wharves equipped with outlets at 200 or 400 amps per phase and 415-volt/50 cycle. Motor generator sets can be provided for ships with special shore power requirements as follows:

440V	60HZ 3 PHASE	up to 80 AMPS
380V	50HZ 3 PHASE	up to 60 AMPS
220V	AC 60HZ 3 PHASE	up to 200 AMPS

Storage Containers

Land based storage containers with or without shelving can be arranged on request for storage of Ship's gear and fittings during refits.

Other storage facilities are available for storage of Ship's tenders and other larger items of equipment.
